What is a CANS assessment?

A CANS assessment is a tool used to determine eligibility for OhioRISE. It gathers the young person and family's story to understand their needs and strengths, and to help determine the best ways to provide help. The CANS assessment is updated regularly to aid with ongoing care planning.

What special services does 3E provide?

- CANS assessments
- Behavioral Health Respite
- TBS
- Parent Education Classes

What is TBS?

Therapeutic Behavioral Services (TBS) are aimed at addressing problematic behaviors in a structured, therapeutic environment. These services allow youth to develop healthy coping mechanisms, communication skills, and emotional regulation strategies, fostering positive behavioral changes.



What does Respite offer families?

Respite offers temporary relief to families, providing a safe space for youth during times of crisis or instability, reducing the likelihood of repeated interactions with the justice system.

How do we incorporate Parent education?

Parent education sessions, families gain the tools necessary to support their child's growth and development at home, further reducing problematic behaviors and family conflicts that often lead to recidivism.

Parents will learn essential skills in areas such as effective communication, positive discipline, and emotional support, empowering them to take an active role in their child's rehabilitation and well-being.

Parent education curriculums offered by accredited parent coaches:

- Triple P Parenting (including Teen)
- Nurturing Parent
- Common Sense Parenting

When can a child or youth start receiving OhioRISE services?

Following a CANS assessment, children and youth found to be eligible are enrolled in OhioRISE effective the date their CANS assessment is submitted.
